On December 3, 2024, the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance amending certain sections of Chapter 16.91, Title 16, of the Sacramento County Code relating to the Sacramento Countywide Transportation Mitigation Fee Program (SCTMFP). The updated Fee Rates are effective February 1, 2025. The new fees were updated using current trip generation rates and are set as follows:

Very Small (<750 sq.ft.)	Exempt from Fee
Otherwise (>750 sq.ft.)	Fee is based on the ratio of the floor area of the ADU compared to the primary unit, times the fee that would be charged on the primary unit, if the primary unit was newly built.
