# Freeport-Delta Gateway Monuments Project

### What is the Freeport-Delta Gateway Monuments Project?

The Freeport-Delta Gateway Monuments Project is a Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SacDOT) effort to develop design concepts to create two gateway monuments (freestanding structure or sign on posts) and one interpretive history sign for the town of Freeport. Grant funding for this effort is administered by the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy as part of their Proposition 68 Community Grant Program.

Prior planning efforts have highlighted historic and cultural aspects that give a unique identity to Freeport and the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta region. Those elements will be incorporated into the design of physical improvements such as the gateway monuments and an interpretive sign. The end result will be a preliminary design that SacDOT may carry toward implementation with future funding. We encourage you to get involved!

### How can you be involved?

SacDOT is eager to hear your vision, concerns, and hopes for the signs. On **Wednesday, March 1, 2023** we will host the first of three community workshops. In this first workshop we will introduce the project, and ask **YOU** for feedback on similar types of existing gateway monument and sign examples that may inspire ideas for the Freeport design.

Design concepts developed from this workshop will be presented and evaluated at future community meetings.

### How does this effort relate to current and future projects?

Funding is in place for the preliminary design of two gateway monument signs and one interpretative sign. A construction schedule for the signs will be contingent on subsequent grant funding.



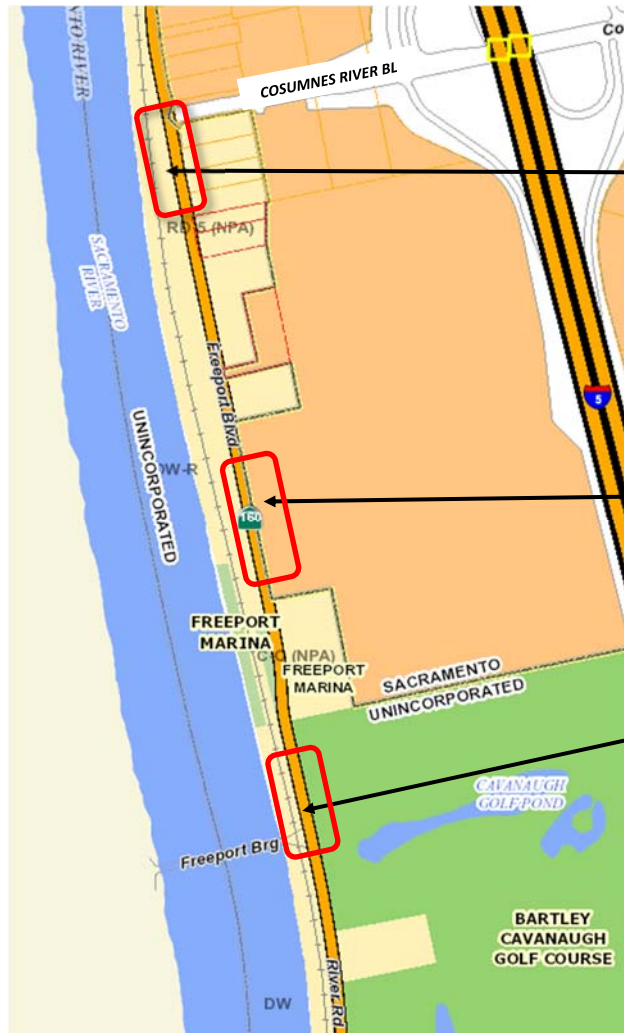
