Construction Activities

The project was bid on January 27, 2022 and has been awarded to Martin General Engineering, Inc. The estimated construction time period is May 2022 to December 2022. Some preliminary work may occur prior to the start of construction such as installation of project information signs, fire hydrant relocation, and grinding tree stumps. Access will be maintained to all residences and businesses during construction.

Project Work Includes

- Construction of curb, gutter, sidewalk and ramps on both sides of Power Inn Road
- Improvements to storm drain facilities
- Installation of street lights
- Placement of slurry seal and restriping


Project Funding

Funding for the project is from the Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) and Measure "A" Sales Tax.




